Worsted weight yarn (approx. 200 yards)

Size 8 knitting needles

Cable needle

Yarn needle

1. Cast on 20 stitches. 2. Row 1: Knit 2, purl 2. Repeat across the row. 3.

Row 2: Purl 2, knit 2. Repeat across the row. 4. Row 3: Knit 2, cable 4, knit

2. Repeat across the row. 5. Row 4: Purl 2, knit 2. Repeat across the row.

6. Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until the scarf is the desired length. 7. Cast off all

stitches. 8. Weave in loose ends.

Your cable knit scarf is now complete!

The lace knit scarf is a beautiful and delicate accessory. The lace


