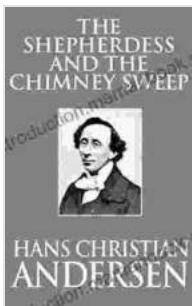


Shepherdess and the Chimney Sweep: A Tale of Love, Loss, and Redemption
