

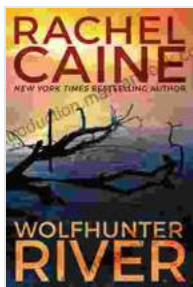

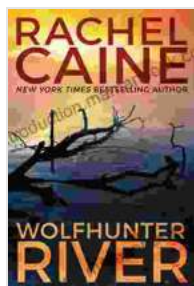
Visitor Information

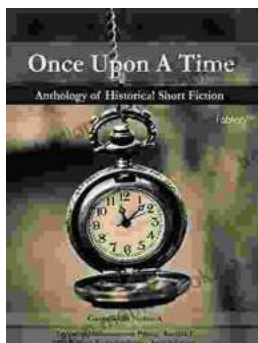
